# AHTCA COMMITTEE MEETING - 8/10/2024

#### **AGENDA**

Matters discussed were as follows and agreement was unanimous unless stated otherwise:

#### **Opening**

The meeting was conducted via Zoom hook-up and was opened by Mr Jervis Ward, who welcomed all Committee present to the Committee meeting.

#### **Secretary/Treasurer Report**

The Secretary/Treasurer Report provided to the meeting was noted.

#### Eligibility

The Committee noted updates provided in the Secretary's Report relating to Specification Sheets and Reference Sheets.

The Committee agreed the following papers to be referred to the Group N Working Group (GNWG) for discussion and decision with the following comments from the AHTCA:

- Submission 6 Vented rotors Group Nb
   This was originally submitted for Jaguars, but has been broadened by the AHTCA to include all Nb cars because:
  - The submission does not change the "form and type" of braking system and therefore complies with that rule;
  - The submission does not request for drum brakes to be replaced by disc brakes and therefore complies with that rule;
  - The submission is not requesting a change to calipers and therefore complies with that rule;
  - Disc pad material available today (composite Kevlar) creates too much heat for a solid rotor – old disc pad material did not create this issue in the day;
  - The submission points out that there are three Group Nb vehicles that already have vented disc rotors (Ford Falcon Rally Sprint, Ford Mercury Comet Caliente, Ford Mustang 64/65 Ford Mustang, so the precedent to have vented disc rotors is already within Class Nb;
  - The availability of original parts for such vehicles is becoming problematic examples given were the Studebaker Lark Daytona and any Ford Cortina.
- Submission 7 Austin A40 Farina Block
  - The Austin Farina competes in Class F (1001 cc to 1300 cc), as its original cubic capacity motor is 1098 cc (bore of 64.58 mm, stroke of 83.8 mm, giving a swept volume of 274492.2), which may be increased to 1149 cc with a 1.5 mm increase in bore and retention of the standard stroke of 83.8mm (bore of 66.08mm, stroke of 83.8mm, giving a swept volume of 287391.5);
  - Crankshafts (north-south) for the original cubic capacity motor (1098 cc side plate) are hard to find and are expensive;
  - The submission requests the resolution of this issue by substituting a block that is readily available (1100 non-side plate), and using the crankshaft and head from that motor (this crankshaft is not interchangeable to the original 1098 cc side plate block):
  - The requested block, head and crankshaft are already permitted component substitutions for the Morris/Austin Mini Cooper "S" Mark 1 (Class NbE), Morris/Austin Mini Cooper "S" Mark 2 (Class NcF), and Leyland Mini Clubman GT (Class NcF).

- Submission 8 Mini Speedometer location
  - any proposed wording needs to be refined to ensure that it is actually practical and legal;
  - o the fact that cars have been built under the old rule needs to be recognised by including a "grandfather" clause indicating that a new modified rule that is practically and legally possible would apply to any vehicle log-booked on or after the date of the rule change, and that the previous rule would be applied for any vehicle built prior to the date of the rule change.

The Committee noted progress with work on providing each State's list of engine sealer to the Secretary.

The Committee noted that old CAMS manuals (sourced mainly from Mr Phil Barrow) have been scanned and placed on the AHTCA website.

The Committee noted that the provision of the AHTCA website and the use of the AHTCA Newsletter as being successful.

#### **General Business**

The Committee agreed to invite a conversation with Mr Gary Hunt.

"During 2020 I made had contact with you on Facebook messenger regarding the prospect of creating Group ND as a way to expand the Group N category to include cars built between 1st January 1973 and the 31st December 1984. This also with the purpose to gain greater participation in historic touring cars whilst also not detracting from A&C Heritage Touring Cars.

Over the period since I first made contact with you in this regard, we have been doing much to progress Group ND and we are now at a time when we believe it's right to approach regulators and start the process to gain approval of Group ND.

At this stage we have a guideline regulation in use at Morgan Park with the QSSS in which a few cars participate, a draft full and detailed set of regulations, a number of cars being built, and we are progressing our own incorporated association. Most of this is visible on our Facebook page where we have over 1,000 members from across the country, including a few former race drivers from the era.

We would like Historic Touring Cars to assist us take this next step with Motorsport Australia and are hoping we can discuss this with you (and/or others in the committee) in the next few weeks.
